[Why Does My Dog's Bark Sound Hoarse?](#)

This is the question we are going to tackle today but be advised that you should always seek out the advice of a veterinarian when it comes to your pet's health. There are, in fact, several reasons you may notice a change in Fido's bark. And, while it may not seem like a big deal, it's better to be sure since it could be a symptom of something more serious. Let's go over the top three most common culprits.

Excessive Barking

If your dog is a [serial barker](#) then your pooch may be putting strain on his throat or irritating his trachea (tracheitis). In this case, figure out how to eliminate the source of their [excessive barking](#) so they can rest their throat. Make sure they drink plenty of water and you may even want to infuse it with a little honey. Try giving your dog one-half tablespoon to 1 tablespoon of honey mixed with a little warm water in a bowl. If the problem persists, make an appointment with your veterinarian. Your vet may prescribe a liquid cough suppressant such as butorphanol or hydrocodone.

Upper Respiratory Infection

With the exception of puppies, elderly dogs, or dogs with compromised immune systems, upper [respiratory infections](#) in dogs are usually mild and last for 7 to 21 days. They can be viral, as with canine flu, or bacterial, as with kennel cough. Cold-like symptoms like sneezing, fatigue, coughing, eye and nose discharge, and a hoarse bark are typical of these infections. Comfort your pet with plenty of water, warm foods, a humidifier, keeping their eyes and noses wiped will help your dog feel better and recover quicker. Of course, if symptoms continue or take a turn downhill, consult with your veterinarian as soon as possible.

Laryngeal Paralysis

Sometimes the nerves of the laryngeal muscles can (the muscles supporting the larynx/voicebox) become weak or paralyzed. As a result, the muscles tend to relax, and the cartilages tend to collapse inwards resulting in laryngeal paralysis. In most cases, the cause is unknown and is often seen in Irish Setters and Labrador Retrievers. Breeds most commonly

born with the condition include Bouvier des Flandres, Siberian Huskies, Bull Terriers, and Dalmatians. Reported symptoms include [coughing](#), noisy breathing, shortness of breath, and change in bark aka dysphonia. Medications and/or surgery can help and may be recommended by your veterinarian.
